This event is part of the Italian Ministry of Cultural Heritage and Activities and Tourism's actions of the 2018 European year of Cultural Heritage. Furthermore, in 2018 we will also celebrate the 50th Anniversary of Matera's Sassi and Park of the Rupestrian Churches inscription in the UNESCO list.

Young volunteers and members of our Committee, **aged 18 to 35**, will lead the three-day event during which they will share ideas, discuss, and plan new strategies for the enhancement, development, and awareness of the Italian cultural heritage.

The Forum will specifically focus on education, innovation, knowledge disclosure, and sustainable development, connecting professionals and experts from national and international organizations.

There will be **some activities open** to the public, upon free registration, such as training workshops with a limited number of participants, where keynote speakers will address the main topics of the forum.

Those taking parts to workshops will meet and exchange views with our **300 members**, including students, researchers, artists, professionals, managers, and entrepreneurs, who constantly work for the promotion of UNESCO values and projects within the Italian territory.
